#### 2. Petition Requirements

Students who petition and have all prerequisite course work completed will have priority acceptance. Students who petition and are still in progress completing prerequisite course work will be considered for acceptance based on seat availability.

- Prerequisite courses (except science courses) with grades of C or higher
- Science courses with B- or higher: BIOSCI-177 & BIOSCI-179 (or BIOSCI-201 & BIOSCI-202), BIOSCI-197, and CHEM-186 (or CHEM-207 & CHEM-208)
- Sciences must be taken within the last five years
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5
- Entrance Exam: HESI (minimum score of 900) (3 lifetime attempts) <u>www.matchealth.com</u>
