2. Petition Requirements

Students who petition and have all prerequisite course work completed will have priority acceptance. Students who petition and are still in progress completing prerequisite course work will be considered for acceptance based on seat availability.

- Prerequisite courses (except science courses) with grades of C or higher
- Science courses with B- or higher: BIOSCI-177 & BIOSCI-179 (or BIOSCI-201 & BIOSCI-202), BIOSCI-197, and CHEM-186 (or CHEM-207 & CHEM-208)
- Sciences must be taken within the last five years.
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5
- Completion of an approved Nursing Assistant training program.
- Entrance Exam: TEAS http://www.matchealth.com
 - Minimum score of 65%
 - o Scores expire and do not qualify after 5 years
 - 3 attempts within a 3 year window
 - (NLN PAX scores taken after June 1, 2023 will only be valid for one year. NLN PAX scores taken before June 1, 2023 will no longer be accepted)
